

*Clinical Intervention Progress Report Guidelines for Juveniles with Sexual Offenses
For NOJOS Providers*

- Juvenile's Name
- Date of Report
- Name of Individual/Group Therapist(s)
- Attendance (*Length of time in treatment, individual, group and family sessions attended, absences, etc.*)
- Participation (*Is the juvenile on time and prepared, completing assignments, participating actively and appropriately in individual and group sessions.*)
- Accountability
- Insight into Factors that Led to Sexual Misconduct (*Pattern of functioning pro-social and antisocial - Understanding of internal processes - demonstration of healthy cycles.*)
- Victim Empathy (*Does the juvenile acknowledge and understand the impact on victim's emotional health, social well-being, medical health, and family?*)
- Parent/Guardian Participation (*Support, attendance, supervision.*)
- Treatment Integration (*including Relapse Prevention Plan*)
- Risk Assessment and Protective Factors (*What risk factors have been targeted in treatment, and how have they been reduced? What protective factors have increased? Provide specific examples.*)
- Safety Plan (*Is there a current safety plan? How well is the client doing at following it? Have there been any changes since the last report, or are there any recommended changes to be addressed at this time? If discharge, future safety plan or guidelines.*)
Attach copy of current safety plan.
- Summary of Progress (*Include description of where client is in the context of the program's phase or level system.*)
- Summary of Challenges (*Include description of any concerns from above and plans to address those concerns.*)
- Will continued NOJOS therapy be recommended at this time? Estimated completion date. (*Explanation of predicted completion date and what still needs to be completed.*)
